BLOOD, who needs it? People like you and me need blood. 70% of us will require a transfusion in our lifetime. Donors must be 17 or older, weigh at least 110 lbs. and are required to bring I.D. (a driver's license, donor card or a social security card). United Blood Services (UBS) staff uses an individual sealed kit for each donor. Each kit is 100% disposable into a biohazard container immediately after the donation. Please prayerfully consider signing up in the lobby for an appointment. There is no substitute for human blood. Our simple act of giving is heroic to patients in our community!
