Leader: God hears your prayer and fills you with the power to live today, tomorrow and every day, enjoying new and abundant life. Live in newness of life. Amen?





Leader: Lift up your heads, O gates; and be lifted up, O everlasting doors, that the King of glory may come in.


All: Who is this King of glory? The Lord, strong and mighty, the Lord, mighty in battle!
